WEEKEND CLOSURE on LAKE WORTH ROAD west of FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE

Fort Lauderdale, FL (September 29, 2009) — Beginning Friday, October 2 construction in Palm Beach County, on Florida's Turnpike will force an **off-peak, full closure of Lake Worth Road between** Akron Road to just east of Hooks Road, for three consecutive nights.

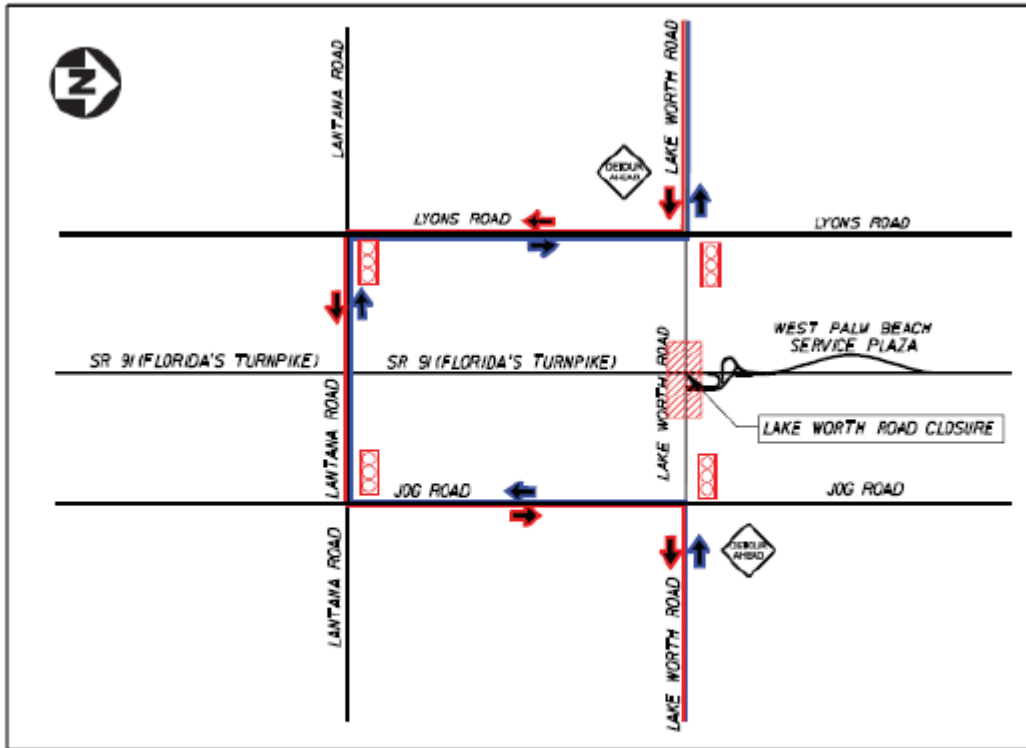
Both the eastbound and westbound lanes on Lake Worth under the Turnpike bridge will be closed to accommodate construction. Construction crews will be setting bridge beams on the Turnpike bridge above Lake Worth Road. The closures dates and times are listed below.

- October 2, Friday 9 p.m. to October 3, Saturday 6 a.m.
- October 3, Saturday 9 p.m. to October 4, Sunday 6 a.m.
- October 4, Sunday 9 p.m. to October 5, Monday 6 a.m.

DETOUR MAP:



Eastbound drivers on Lake Worth Road should follow the red arrows.

Westbound drivers on Lake Worth Road should follow the blue arrows.

The Lake Worth Interchange (Exit 93) is currently a trumpet configuration, meaning both the northbound and southbound ramps lead in and out of one toll plaza. The current toll plaza is located on the northbound side of the Turnpike at Lake Worth Road.

The newly constructed southbound entry and exit will be built at the southwest corner of the interchange.

The northbound entry and exit will remain in its current location
