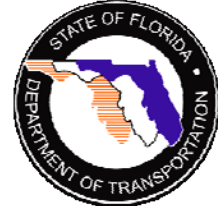

***Florida Department of Transportation and Florida's Turnpike Enterprise Host Toll Rate Hearing To Solicit Comments on Proposed Toll Rates for I-4/Lee Roy Selmon Expressway Interchange (Connector)***

OCOE, FL--Florida's Turnpike Enterprise, part of the Florida Department of Transportation, is hosting a Toll Rate Public Hearing to present and solicit comments on the proposed toll rates for the I-4/Lee Roy Selmon Expressway Interchange (Connector) in Hillsborough County. The hearing will be held at 6 p.m., Thursday, September 30.

The Department is constructing the Connector, a limited-access interchange that extends from the Lee Roy Selmon Expressway north along the west side of 31<sup>st</sup> Street to Interstate 4. Tolls will be collected via SunPass and TOLL-BY-PLATE technologies as vehicles pass under a toll gantry located on the project south of 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue.

This Toll Rate Public Hearing is being held in accordance with Chapter 120, Florida Statutes and Chapter 28-109, Florida Administrative Code. Public participation is solicited without regard to race, color, national origin, age, sex, religion, disability, or family status. Persons with disabilities who require special accommodations under the Americans with Disabilities Act or persons who require translation services (free of charge) should contact Ms. Christa Deason, Public Information Officer, at least seven (7) days prior to the hearing.
