One northbound SunPass-only lane closed at the Turnpike's Okeechobee toll plaza;
will remain closed through mid-June

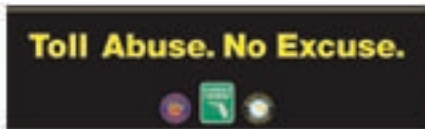
FORT LAUDERDALE — The northbound SunPass-only lane at the Turnpike's Okeechobee mainline toll plaza closed at 2 p.m. today for drainage pipe repairs, and is expected to remain closed until mid-June. The toll plaza is located at Milepost 32 on the Turnpike Extension in Miami-Dade County.

SunPass customers entering northbound Florida's Turnpike from Northwest 74th Street will have four cash/SunPass lanes available. However, they may experience slower traffic during peak times due to the closure of the SunPass-only lane.

Northbound motorists who normally use the SunPass-only express lanes (open road tolling lanes) will not be affected, because these lanes remain open.

The drainage pipe repairs are part of the ongoing construction project that added the SunPass-only express lanes and converted Okeechobee toll plaza into an open road tolling facility. It is anticipated the project will be completed this summer.

SunPass is the Florida Department of Transportation's innovative Prepaid Toll Program. SunPass can be used on Florida's toll roads and most toll bridges.
