PGA (Exit 109) SOUTHBOUND TURNPIKE ENTRANCE CLOSED NIGHTS of Nov. 1 & Nov. 3

Fort Lauderdale, FL (October 28, 2010) —Turnpike's southbound entrance ramp at Palm Beach Gardens / PGA Boulevard (Exit 109) will be closed for two nights. The closures will take place on Monday, November 1 from 11 p.m. until Tuesday, November 2 at 4 a.m. and again on Wednesday, November 3 from 11 p.m. until Thursday, November 4 at 4 a.m.

The 45th Street Bridge which crosses over the Turnpike is being replaced. Construction crews are working on the bridge to achieve additional clearance.

The recommended detours for drivers from PGA Boulevard who wish to access the Turnpike in the southbound direction are as follows:

- PGA Boulevard east to Military Trail
- Military Trail south to Okeechobee Blvd
- West on Okeechobee Blvd

In order to complete the bridge replacement, there will be another set of nighttime closures in the northbound direction. The northbound entrance at Okeechobee Blvd (Exit 99) is projected to be closed the nights of November 15 and November 17.
