Southbound Turnpike entrance ramp from Red Road/NW 57<sup>th</sup> Avenue to close for the weekend;  
northbound exit ramp to Kendall Drive to close tonight

FORT LAUDERDALE — The Florida's Turnpike southbound entrance ramp from Red Road/ Northwest 57<sup>th</sup> Avenue (Exit 43) is scheduled to close for the weekend, from at 9 p.m. Friday, July 9, through 6 a.m. Monday, July 12, for grading and paving activities. Should the work be completed before Monday morning, the ramp will reopen earlier.

Motorists who wish to enter the southbound Turnpike from Red Road should take Miramar Parkway east to University Drive/Northwest 27<sup>th</sup> Avenue and use the Turnpike entrance ramp at that location.

In addition, the Turnpike's northbound exit ramp to Kendall Drive/Southwest 88<sup>th</sup> Street (Exit 20) will be closed tonight, between 11:45 p.m. and 5:30 a.m., for emergency repairs. While the ramp is closed, travelers should exit at Southwest 120<sup>th</sup> Street (Exit 19) and take Southwest 117<sup>th</sup> Avenue north to Kendall Drive.

Electronic signs will be installed to advise drivers about the ramp closures and detours.
