NIGHTIME CLOSURES at COMMERCIAL BOULEVARD (EXIT 62) NORTHBOUND TURNPIKE ENTRANCE

FT. LAUDERDALE, FL (October 28, 2010) – Construction in Broward County on Florida's Turnpike will force off-peak closures of the Commercial Boulevard northbound entrance to Florida's Turnpike. These closures will begin Monday, November 1 and could last up to 7 nights. The southbound entrance will remain open during this time.

The scheduled closure dates and times are as follows:

- November 1, Monday 11 p.m. to November 2, Tuesday 5 a.m.
- November 2, Tuesday 11 p.m. to November 3, Wednesday 5 a.m.
- November 3, Wednesday 11 p.m. to November 4, Thursday 5 a.m.
- November 4, Thursday 11 p.m. to November 5, Friday 5 a.m.
- November 7, Sunday 11 p.m. to November 8, Monday 5 a.m.
- November 8, Monday 11 p.m. to November 9, Tuesday 5 a.m.
- November 9, Tuesday 11 p.m. to November 10, Wednesday 5 a.m.
- November 10, Wednesday 11 p.m. to November 11, Thursday 5 a.m.

Drivers who wish to enter the Turnpike northbound should proceed to SR 7 / US 441 north. Take SR 7 / US 441 north to Coconut Creek and then drive east on Coconut Creek to enter the Turnpike. Construction crews will be completing the newly aligned northbound entrance ramp and sound wall. This ramp was realigned to connect the additional northbound lane being added to the Turnpike. The "Broward Widening" is a multi-year, multi-million dollar construction program to widen Florida's Turnpike in Broward County from six to eight lanes. The project is projected to be completed winter 2011.
