## NORTHBOUND TURNPIKE EXIT RAMP CLOSED at ATLANTIC BLVD (EXIT 66) NIGHTS of OCT 4 thru 7

**FT. LAUDERDALE, FL (September 30, 2010)** – Roadway widening construction in Broward County will force nighttime closures on the Turnpike's Atlantic Boulevard (Exit 66) northbound exit ramp. This closure will take place on October 4 through October 7 between 10 p.m. and 5 a.m. Drivers may use Coconut Creek (Exit 67) as their exit alternate.

An additional lane is being added to the Turnpike as part of the "Broward Widening". The "Broward Widening" is a multi-year, multi-million dollar construction program to widen Florida's Turnpike in Broward County from six to eight lanes. The project is projected to be completed summer of 2011.
