Upcoming Ramp Closures on Florida's Turnpike

Fort Lauderdale, FL (January 14, 2007) — Due to two Turnpike, nonrelated, maintenance repairs and construction there will be a couple of ramp closures next week. Both closures will take place on January 22, Tuesday at 10 p.m. and will run until January 23, Wednesday at 5 a.m. If work is not completed within in the first evening a contingency work night for January 23, Wednesday 10 p.m. through January 24, Thursday at 5 a.m. is reserved.

The first closure is in Miami-Dade County at the northbound Turnpike entrance ramp to the Golden Glades Interchange from US 441. Drivers may use US 441 northbound, proceed to NE 199 Street head westbound to use the Dolphin Stadium Turnpike entrance ramp as their alternate.

The second closure is in Broward County at the Sample Road Interchange (Exit 69). The southbound Turnpike entrance ramp at Sample Road will be closed. Drivers may use the southbound Turnpike entrance at Coconut Creek Parkway (Exit 67) as their alternate.

Electronic message boards have been set up to give motorists advanced warnings of these closures.
