TURNPIKE TRAFFIC AT ATLANTIC AVENUE TO SHIFT WEDNESDAY NIGHT, JANUARY 16

Fort Lauderdale, Florida (January 14, 2008) — All northbound traffic on Florida's Turnpike at Atlantic Avenue in Delray Beach will be shifted to the west, onto the new bridge Wednesday night starting around 9 p.m. Thursday evening, January 17, is set as a contingency work night.

Motorists exiting the Turnpike at Atlantic Avenue should use the dedicated extreme right exit lane as it is currently configured.

Motorists should drive with extreme caution through the work zone and adhere to posted signs and speed limits. Speeding fines double in construction zones when workers are present.

Work to widen the Turnpike and reconfiguration of the Atlantic Avenue Interchange began in September 2005. Construction will continue through late 2008/early 2009. The contractor of this project is Condotte America, Inc., with engineering and inspection services provided by Tampa Bay Engineering Group.
