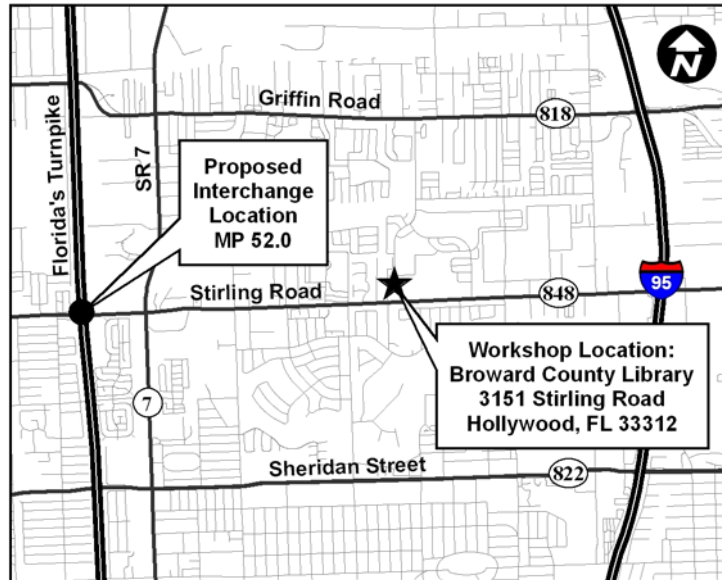




PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING NOTICE
NEW INTERCHANGE AT FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE MAINLINE
AND STIRLING ROAD
PROJECT DEVELOPMENT & ENVIRONMENT (PD&E) STUDY
BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), Florida's Turnpike Enterprise, has scheduled a Public Information Meeting for the proposed new interchange at Florida's Turnpike Mainline and Stirling Road. **The Meeting will be held at the Broward County Public Library – Stirling Road Branch, located at 3151 Stirling Road in Hollywood, Florida on August 8, 2006, from 5:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m.** (see Location Map). In the event that severe weather or other unforeseen conditions cause the Meeting to be postponed,



it will be held on the alternate date of August 29, 2006 at the same time and location. The Public Information Meeting will consist of an open house with maps, drawings, and pertinent information developed by the FDOT, Florida's Turnpike Enterprise. These items will be available for review from 5:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. Representatives from Florida's Turnpike Enterprise will be available to discuss the project and receive comments.

This Meeting will be held to inform interested persons and provide the opportunity to express their views concerning the preliminary design and any social, economic, and environmental effects of the proposed new Turnpike interchange at Stirling Road. Improvements to the drainage system, signing, pavement markings, and lighting are also being considered. This Meeting is being held as part the of the Project Development and Environment (PD&E) Study that is now underway.

Impacts to wetlands and floodplains are being considered under Executive Orders 11990 and 11988. The proposed project is being developed in accordance with the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended, and the Civil Rights Act of 1968, as amended.
