NUMBER OF TOLL LANES REDUCED AGAIN AT COMMERCIAL BOULEVARD TOLL PLAZA (EXIT 62)

FT. LAUDERDALE, FL (May 6, 2008) – Beginning, Tuesday night, May 13, one of the lanes exiting the Commercial Boulevard Toll Plaza will be closed around the clock. This closure may remain in place until fall 2008. This will be the second lane closed at Commercial Boulevard Toll Plaza (Exit 62). One of the three southbound, toll plaza lanes entering the Turnpike has been closed for the past several months.

Because access to and from the Commercial Boulevard plaza is temporarily limited, cash customers are encouraged to use the Sunrise Boulevard Interchange (Exit 58) as their alternate route during construction. Currently, there are message boards set up on eastbound and westbound Commercial Boulevard near the entrance to the toll plaza, advising drivers of the upcoming closure as well as boards set up on the Turnpike.

The double lane closure at the plaza is necessary to rebuild the plaza ramps. The ramps are being modified to accommodate the widening of the Turnpike underneath. This work is part of the multi-year, multi-million dollar "Turnpike Widening Program," in Broward County, which began February 2006.
