Public Hearing for Widening Florida's Turnpike from North of Lake Worth Road to North of Jupiter/Indiantown Road to be held Thursday, September 20

FORT LAUDERDALE, FL — The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), Florida's Turnpike Enterprise, has scheduled a public hearing for the proposed widening of Florida's Turnpike from north of Lake Worth Road to north of Jupiter/Indiantown Road in Palm Beach County. This project proposes to expand the Turnpike to eight lanes along this corridor.

The open house will be held at 5:30 p.m. Thursday, September 20. The open-house portion of the hearing will be followed at 6:30 p.m. by a formal presentation and a public comment period. It will take place at the PGA National Resort & Spa, 400 Avenue of the Champions, Palm Beach Gardens, FL 33418.

This hearing is being held to afford interested persons the opportunity to express their views concerning the location, right-of-way, conceptual design, social, economic, and environmental effects of the proposed project.

If this hearing cannot be held on September 20 due to a hurricane or other unforeseen event, the meeting will be rescheduled for October 2 at the same time and location.
