PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING TO BE HELD THURSDAY RE SUNRISE BOULEVARD INTERCHANGE MODIFICATIONS AT FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE

FORT LAUDERDALE, FL (November 2, 2006) — The Florida Department of Transportation, Florida's Turnpike Enterprise, has scheduled a public information meeting to advise the public and receive comments about modifications to the Turnpike interchange at Sunrise Boulevard (Exit 58), in Broward County.
