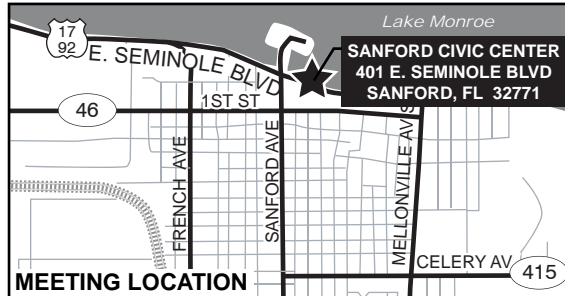


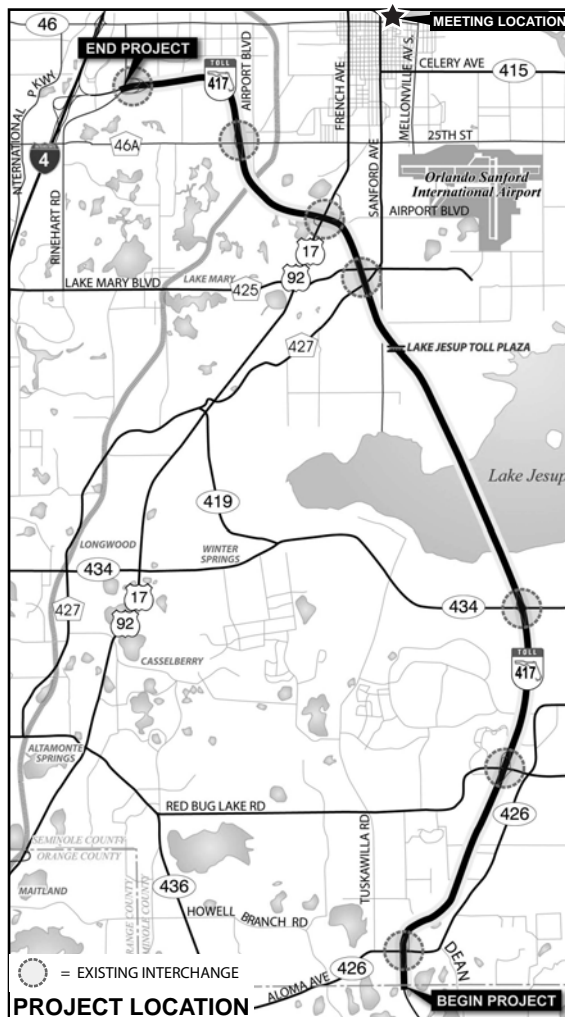
PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING



Florida's Turnpike Enterprise Seminole Expressway Widening Project Development and Environment (PD&E) Study Seminole County, Florida Financial Project ID: 417545-1



The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), Florida's Turnpike Enterprise has scheduled a Public Information Meeting for the proposed widening of the Seminole Expressway (SR 417) from the Orange County line (MP 38) to the Rinehart Road Interchange (MP 54) in Seminole County. **The meeting will be held at the Sanford Civic Center, 401 East Seminole Boulevard, Sanford, Florida on October 12, 2006 from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m.** In the event that severe weather or other unforeseen conditions cause the meeting to be postponed, it will be held on the alternate date of October 24, 2006 at the same time and location.



The meeting will be conducted as an informal open house with maps, drawings, and other pertinent information available for public review. Florida's Turnpike Enterprise representatives will be available to discuss the project and answer questions.

This meeting will afford interested persons the opportunity to express their views concerning the location, conceptual design and social, economic and environmental effects of the proposed widening. These improvements are necessary to effectively meet future travel demand in the corridor.

Impacts to wetlands and floodplains are being considered under Executive Orders 11990 and 11988. Right of way acquisition is anticipated for the project. The proposed project is being developed in accordance with the Civil Rights Acts of 1964 and 1968, as amended. Under Title VI and Title VIII of the Civil Rights Acts, any person(s) or beneficiary who
