



**Project Development & Environment (PD&E) Study  
NEW INTERCHANGE AT FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE MAINLINE  
AND STIRLING ROAD**

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), Florida's Turnpike Enterprise, has scheduled a Public Hearing to which all persons are invited. This hearing is being held to afford interested persons the opportunity to express their views concerning the location, conceptual design, social, economic, and environmental effects of the proposed project. The Public Hearing will be held on **October 11, 2007**, at the **Broward County Public Library – Stirling Road Branch, located at 3151 Stirling Road in Hollywood, Florida 33312**. In the event that severe weather or other unforeseen conditions cause the hearing to be postponed, it will be held on the alternate date of



October 25, 2007 at the same time and location. The hearing will be conducted with an open house from 6:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. at which time the public may review maps, drawings and pertinent information developed by the FDOT. The open house will be followed by a formal presentation at 7:00 p.m. followed by the public comment period. The project evaluated the construction of a new interchange at the Florida's Turnpike Mainline and Stirling Road in Broward County. **Based on the impacts and cost associated with the construction of the interchange, the No-Build Alternative is the preferred option for this project.**

This hearing is being conducted pursuant to the provisions of Rule 14-97, Florida Administrative Code, and Section 335.18, Florida Statutes. This hearing is being noticed and held in accordance with Section 339.155, Florida Statutes, Chapter 120, Florida Statutes, and is consistent with the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990. Right-of-way acquisition is not anticipated for this project.

The proposed project is being developed in accordance with the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and the Civil Rights Act of 1968, as amended. Under Title VI and Title VIII of the Civil Rights Acts, any person(s) or beneficiary who believes they have been subjected to discrimination because of race, color, sex, age, national origin, or disability may file a written complaint with the FDOT's Equal Opportunity Office, 605 Suwannee Street, Room 260, MS 65, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-0450.
