PUBLIC HEARING and TOLL RATE DEVELOPMENT WORKSHOP
To be held on July 31, Thursday
Regarding Proposed Sunrise Boulevard Interchange Modifications

FORT LAUDERDALE, FL (July 24, 2008) — The Florida Department of Transportation, Florida's Turnpike Enterprise, has scheduled a public hearing to advise the public and receive comments about the proposed interchange improvements at Sunrise Blvd (Exit 58) and the Turnpike, in Broward County.

The public hearing will be held on Thursday, July 31 at the Sadkin Community Center located at 1176 NW 42nd Way; Lauderhill, FL 33313. This hearing is part of an ongoing Project Development and Environment Study. An informal open house will begin at 5:30 p.m. And a formal presentation will begin at 6:30 p.m.

The Toll Rate Rule Development Workshop is being conducted to give interested persons an opportunity to comment on the proposed toll rates for the project as well as allow them to express their views concerning the location, conceptual design, social, economic, and environmental effects of the proposed interchange improvements at Sunrise Blvd (Exit 58).
