Lanes to close overnight Sept. 7-10 at Alligator Alley toll plazas

FORT LAUDERDALE — Work to install traffic delineators and pavement markings at the toll plazas on Interstate 75 (Alligator Alley/Everglades Parkway) will require overnight lane closures beginning Sunday, Sept. 7.

Three toll lanes are scheduled to close at the *eastbound* toll plaza in Collier County from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. for two nights — Sunday night, Sept. 7, and Monday night, Sept. 8, beginning at 9 p.m. One traffic lane will close concurrently, entering and leaving the toll plaza, between Milepost 99.5 and Milepost 100.5. At least one traffic lane and two toll lanes will remain open at all times.

In addition, three toll lanes are scheduled to close at the *westbound* toll plaza in Broward County from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. Wednesday night, Sept. 9, and Thursday night, Sept. 10. One traffic lane will close concurrently, entering and leaving the toll plaza, between Milepost 23.5 and Milepost 24.5. At least one traffic lane and two toll lanes will remain open at all times.

Electronic message signs will be placed on the highway to advise motorists about the upcoming work and associated the lane closures.

Should weather or other unforeseen conditions impede the work, it will be rescheduled for the following nights until the work is complete.

The work is part of a \$47,000 project to install traffic delineators and pavement markings at both I-75 toll plazas.
