ACCESS REOPENED for WIDE LOAD TRUCKS at COMMERCIAL BOULEVARD (EXIT 62)

FT. LAUDERDALE, FL (July 21, 2008) – Effective immediately, access for wide load trucks exiting Florida's Turnpike southbound at Commercial Boulevard Toll Plaza (Exit 62) has reopened.

In mid May 2008, wide load trucks were restricted from exiting the Turnpike at Commercial Blvd. They were directed to use Coconut Creek (Exit 67) or Sunrise Boulevard (Exit 58) as their alternates. This limitation was due to construction at the Commercial Boulevard Toll Plaza.

Construction has been underway at the Commercial Boulevard Toll Plaza as part of the Broward Widening. The Broward Widening is the first phase of a multi-year, multi-million dollar construction program to widen Florida's Turnpike in Broward County from six to eight lanes.
