Michael Palozzi, representing the Courtney Campbell Causeway CAG, related that CAG's designation status, their recent fundraising activities, and their CMP.

The purpose of today's meeting was to review the SHAC Comments for the Suncoast Parkway's Scenic Highway Eligibility Application (attached).
