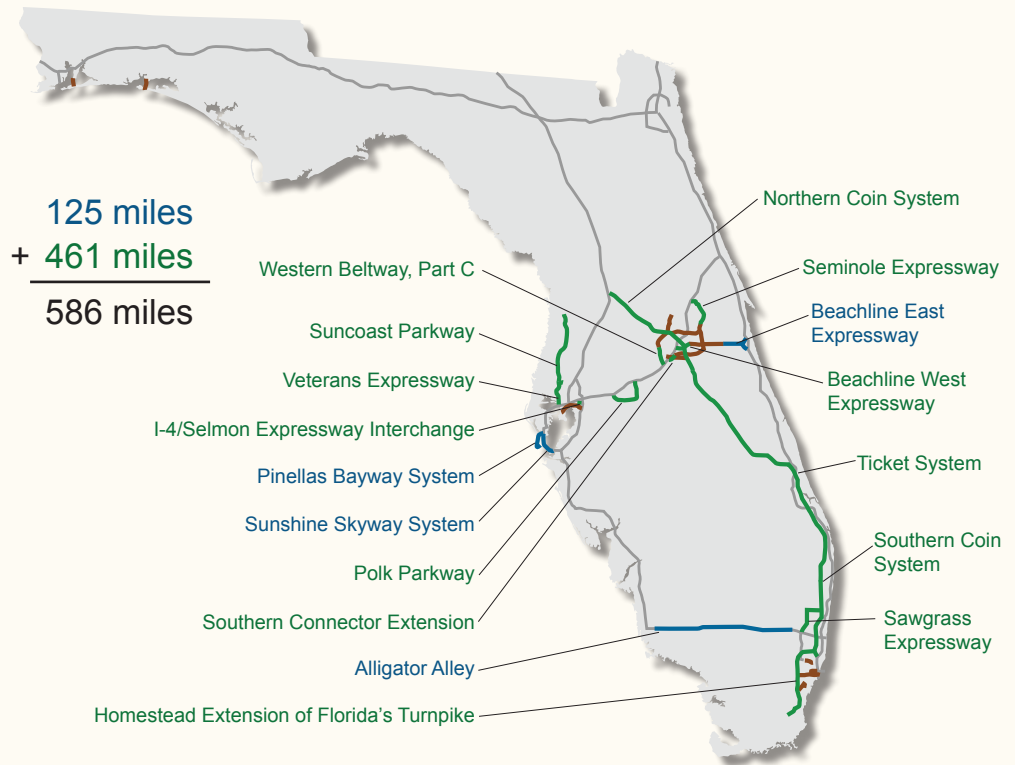


PROPOSED TOLL RATE CHANGES FOR INDEXING IN 2012



- Mandated by Florida Statutes
- Implement by June 30, 2012
- All FDOT and Turnpike toll roads and bridges (see map)
- Indexing of toll rates to adjust for inflation (CPI)
- Funding for improvements not keeping pace with demand
- SunPass toll rate has not had an increase since 1993
- SunPass is always the lowest toll rate



TOLL METHODOLOGY

2012

Cash
Adjust for last five years of inflation (11.7%)
adjusted to next quarter = 25¢ increase

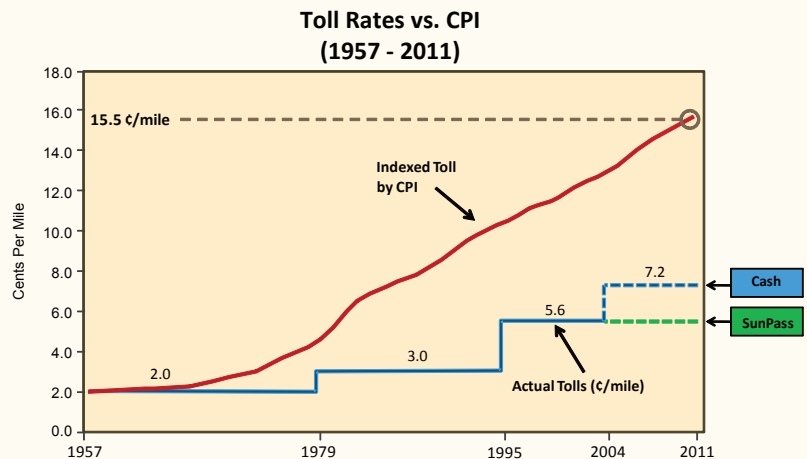
SunPass
25¢ less than cash
or
25% less than cash (Ticket System)

TOLL-BY-PLATE
(where available)
Adjusted same as cash

2013 and Beyond

Cash
Adjusted every 5th year
(change of CPI over last 5 years)

SunPass and TOLL-BY-PLATE
Adjusted annually for CPI

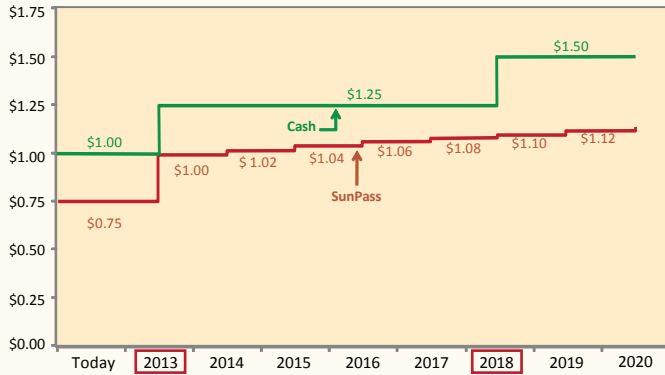

PROPOSED RATE CHANGES AT TYPICAL MAINLINE PLAZAS

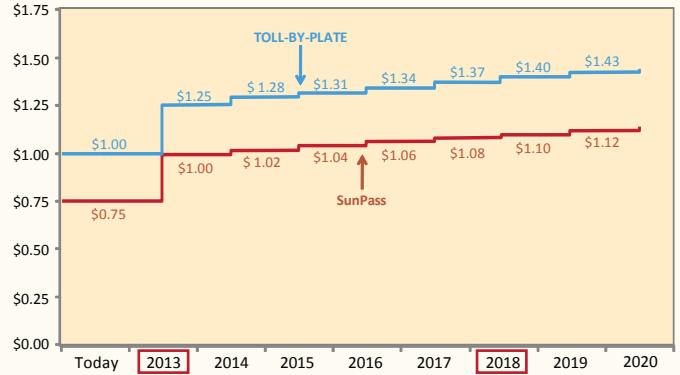
2-Axle Passenger Vehicles (Future Years Estimated)

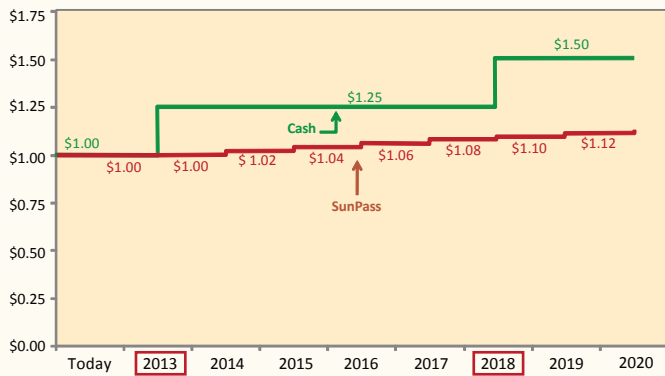

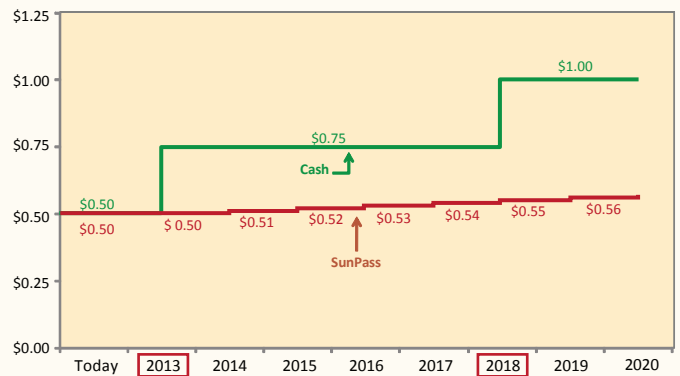

TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENTS ADVANCED

Additional revenues from indexing of toll rates will be used to advance much needed transportation improvements that include:

- Building Sections of Wekiva Parkway in Lake, Seminole and Orange Counties
- Widening of Turnpike in Orange and Osceola Counties (MP 249-254)
- Widening of Veterans Expressway in Hillsborough County
- Widening of Turnpike in Miami-Dade County (MP 5-20)
- Conversion of Turnpike Mainline to All-Electronic Tolling (AET)
- Golden Glades Interchange Improvement
