Full Closure on Florida's Turnpike Southbound Scheduled for Thursday, December 6

WESTON – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is scheduled to close the southbound lanes of Florida's Turnpike between Red Road and Snake Creek Canal for sign structure installation. This closure will take place 11 p.m. Thursday, December 6 until 6 a.m. Friday, December 7.

During this closure, southbound Florida's Turnpike motorists wishing to continue south will be detoured to exit at Red Road (Exit 43), travel north on Red Road to Miramar Parkway, west on Miramar Parkway to I-75, then south on I-75 to take the exit ramp to Florida's Turnpike (Exit 5).

In order to complete the work, this closure may also take place 11 p.m. Monday, December 10 until 6 a.m. Tuesday, December 11.

In the event of inclement weather or other unexpected conditions this work will be rescheduled.
