CLOSING - All Northbound Florida's Turnpike Lanes at the Sunrise Boulevard Interchange Nightly Closures from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. Sunday, July 15 through Thursday, July 19

FORT LAUDERDALE — The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) has scheduled full lane closures on northbound Florida's Turnpike to allow crews to perform bridge demolition and construction activities. To perform this work safely, traffic will be detoured during the following dates and times:

- **All northbound lanes on Florida's Turnpike at the I-595 interchange** will be closed nightly from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, July 15 through Thursday, July 19. Motorists will be directed to exit the Florida's Turnpike at I-595 (Exit 54), travel east on I-595 to US 441/SR 7, travel north on US 441/SR 7 to Sunrise Boulevard where they will be able to access northbound Florida's Turnpike. As an alternate route, motorists can also exit at Griffin Road (Exit 53), travel east on Griffin Road to US 441/SR 7, travel north on US 441/SR 7 to Sunrise Boulevard where they will be able to access northbound Florida's Turnpike.
- **The ramps to northbound Florida's Turnpike from eastbound and westbound I-595** will also be closed nightly from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, July 15 through Thursday, July 19. Motorists on I-595 will be directed to exit at US 441/SR 7 (Exit 9A), travel northbound on US 441/SR 7 to Sunrise Boulevard where they will be able to access northbound Florida's Turnpike.
- In coordination with these closures, access to the 595 Express Lanes from northbound Florida's Turnpike will also be closed nightly from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.

This work is part of the ongoing Sunrise Boulevard Interchange Modifications project at Florida's Turnpike. Please note that this schedule may change due to inclement weather or other unforeseen conditions.
