CLOSING - All Southbound Turnpike lanes at SW 120th Street To be closed nightly from 11 p.m. Thursday, October 12 to 5 a.m. Friday, October 13

FORT LAUDERDALE —The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) has scheduled full closures on southbound Florida's Turnpike to allow crews to pour concrete for bridge construction in the area. In order to perform this work safely, traffic will be detoured during the following dates and times:

- **All southbound lanes on Florida's Turnpike at SW 120th Street** will be closed from 11 p.m. Thursday, October 12 to 5 a.m. Friday, October 13. Motorists will be directed to exit at SW 120th Street (Exit 19), travel east along SW 120th Street, travel south on Southwest 117th Avenue to SW 152nd Street/Coral Reef Drive, and travel east on SW 152nd Street/Coral Reef Drive to re-enter southbound Florida's Turnpike. If necessary to complete the work, these lane closures will also take place nightly from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. Wednesday, October 18 and Thursday, October 19.
- **The southbound Florida's Turnpike entrance ramp from SW 120th Street** will be closed from 11 p.m. Thursday, October 12 to 5 a.m. Friday, October 13. Motorists will be directed to continue east on SW 120th Street, travel south on Southwest 117th Avenue to SW 152nd Street/Coral Reef Drive, and travel east on SW 152nd Street/Coral Reef Drive to re-enter southbound Florida's Turnpike. If necessary to complete the work, these lane closures will also take place nightly from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. Wednesday, October 18 and Thursday, October 19.

This work is part of the ongoing \$145.3 million widening project on Florida's Turnpike between Eureka Drive/SW 184th Street to Killian Parkway/SW 104th Street. Please note that this schedule may change due to inclement weather or other unexpected conditions.
