Overnight Ramp Closures at Florida's Turnpike and Glades Road Interchange

Traffic will be detoured nightly from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. Sunday, December 17 through Thursday, December 21

FORT LAUDERDALE — The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) has scheduled the closure of the Florida's Turnpike northbound and southbound exit and entrance ramps from Glades Road (Exit 75) to allow crews to remove a sign structure. In order to complete this work safely, traffic will be detoured during the following dates and times:

- **Florida's Turnpike northbound exit ramp to Glades Road will be closed nightly from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. Wednesday, December 20 and Thursday, December 21.** Motorists will be detoured to exit northbound Turnpike at Sample Road (Exit 69), travel east on Sample Road and north on Powerline Road to Glades Road.
- **Florida's Turnpike northbound entry ramp from Glades Road will be closed from 9 p.m. Sunday, December 17 to 5 a.m. Monday, December 18. If necessary to complete the work, these ramp closures will also take place from 9 p.m. Monday, December 18 to 5 a.m. Tuesday, December 19.** Motorists wishing to enter northbound Turnpike will be directed to travel north on Powerline Road, travel west on Atlantic Avenue to enter northbound Turnpike.
- **Florida's Turnpike southbound entry ramp from Glades Road will be closed from 9 p.m. Sunday, December 17 to 5 a.m. Monday, December 18. If necessary to complete the work, these ramp closures will also take place from 9 p.m. Monday, December 18 to 5 a.m. Tuesday, December 19.** Motorists wishing to enter southbound Turnpike will be directed to travel south on Powerline Road, travel west on Sample Road to enter southbound Turnpike.

This work is part of an ongoing \$8.3 million Interchange Improvement project at Glades Road and Florida's Turnpike in Boca Raton. Please note that this schedule may change due to inclement weather or other unexpected conditions.
