CLOSING – All Lanes on Northbound Veterans Expressway at Linebaugh Avenue From 10 p.m., Friday, September 29, to 5 p.m., Saturday, September 30

OCOEE — The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) has scheduled the closure of all northbound lanes on the Veterans Expressway at Linebaugh Avenue in order to remove and replace asphalt on the approach to the Rocky Creek Bridge. To perform this work safely, traffic will be detoured during the following dates and times:

- **Veterans Expressway northbound at Linebaugh Avenue, full closure all lanes, beginning at 10 p.m., Friday, September 29 and continuing until 5 p.m., Saturday, September 30.**
 - NORTHBOUND DETOUR – Exit at Linebaugh Avenue and travel west to Sheldon Road, then travel north to Citrus Park Drive/Gunn Highway, then travel east to re-enter the northbound Veterans Expressway.
 - ALTERNATE DETOUR – Motorists on Linebaugh Avenue or Wilsky Boulevard can travel east on Linebaugh Avenue to Anderson Road, then travel north to Citrus Park Drive/Gunn Highway, then travel west to enter the northbound Veterans Expressway.

This work is part of an improvement project that widened 11 miles of the Veterans Expressway in Hillsborough County from four to eight lanes and converted the roadway to all-electronic tolling.

Please note that this schedule may change due to inclement weather or other unexpected conditions.
