



Sunrise Boulevard Interchange Improvements at Milepost 58 Reconstruction & AET Conversion FPID: 406103-1

March 2015

Description:

The Sunrise Boulevard interchange proposed improvements include; one single-lane ramp for eastbound Sunrise Boulevard traffic entering the Turnpike southbound, and one single-lane ramp for northbound Turnpike traffic exiting at Sunrise Boulevard to travel eastbound. In addition, new ramp toll gantries and buildings will be constructed for the Turnpike southbound on ramp from westbound Sunrise Boulevard and Turnpike northbound off ramp to westbound Sunrise Boulevard. Electronic (SunPass)/Toll-By-Plate tolls will be collected at new tolling points with an electronic toll gantry. The existing toll plaza on the northeast quadrant of Sunrise Boulevard will be demolished. This project also includes the replacement of the Sunrise Boulevard Bridge over the Turnpike.

Benefits:

- Significantly enhances safety by eliminating physical barriers in travel lanes, stopping/slowing conditions, and decision points for drivers.
- Increases mobility and reductions in delay at the tolling points.
- Improves traffic flow through the interchange area.

Status:

This project is scheduled for construction in fall 2015.

Investment:

This \$65 million project is funded entirely by FDOT, Florida's Turnpike Enterprise



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
