



# Turnpike/SR 91 and I-75 Interchange Modification FPID: 406110-1

**March 2015**

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## **Description:**

This is a project to upgrade the existing interchange on the Turnpike/SR 91 at I-75 located at Milepost (MP) 309 in Sumter County. This project includes dedicated ramps that are separated from the Mainline roadways, and eliminate the existing weave condition which is created by both the close proximity of the I-75 Interchanges at the Turnpike/SR 91 and SR 44, and the large volume of truck traffic using the Turnpike/SR 91 and I-75 in this area.

Florida's Turnpike Enterprise (FTE) is implementing this project in close coordination with FDOT District 5, who is concurrently implementing a project immediately to the south that widens I-75 from four to six lanes.

## **Benefits:**

- Improves safety and traffic operations in this area by eliminating the lane-changing (weave) maneuvers of the existing roadway condition.
- Utilizes a new concept that solves traffic operation conditions (described above) with less environmental impacts and for a lower project cost.

## **Status:**

Currently, a design consultant is developing a design criteria package and a request for proposal. Design Build acquisition process is underway. Project will be awarded for construction in November 2015.

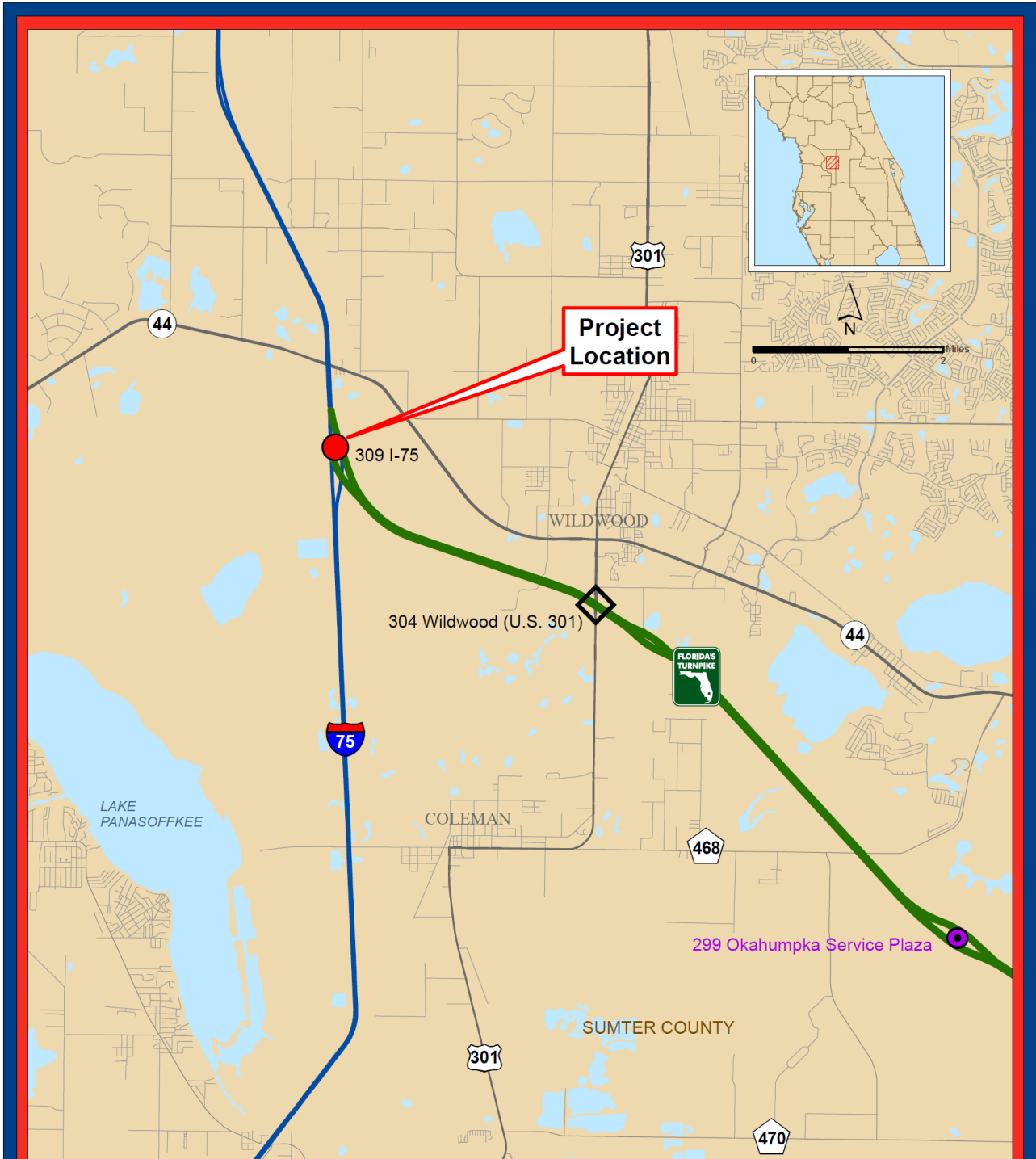
## **Investment:**
