



Turnpike/SR 91

Widening

FPID: 411406-1, -4 and 429018-4, -6

Description:

This project widens a five-mile segment of the Turnpike/SR 91 from the Osceola County Line (MP 249.3) to the Beachline Expressway/SR 528 (MP 254) from four to eight travel lanes, including two (2) express lanes in both directions. The final three ramp movements at the Turnpike (MP 251)/SR 417 system-to-system interchange are also included in this project. This will be the final phase of three phases of construction in order to complete the interchange movements.

This project also includes pavement milling and resurfacing, right-of-way costs, roadside improvements, safety guardrail, signing, and pavement marking improvements.

Benefits:

- Provides much needed capacity improvements, with two new travel lanes in each direction.
- Allows drivers a choice between the express lanes or the general toll lanes.
- The guardrail is a safety improvement that helps minimize the risk of vehicle crossovers in the event of an accident.

Status:

This project is scheduled for construction in FY 2016.

Investment:

The Turnpike has funded \$142 million for the construction phase of this project.
