



FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE



RESURFACING PROJECT IN PALM BEACH COUNTY

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

- ◆ Asphalt milling and resurfacing on Florida's Turnpike from north of Lake Worth Road (Exit 93) to south of Beeline Highway (Exit 107)
- ◆ Includes improvements to signing and pavement markings

The following ramps will be resurfaced:

- Southern Boulevard
- Jog Road
- Okeechobee Boulevard



CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE

Work at the Florida's Turnpike from north of Lake Worth Road to south of Beeline Highway is anticipated to begin in September 2017 and continue through late 2018.

COST AND FUNDING

The project cost is approximately \$16.8 million. This project is funded by toll and concessions revenue, not taxes.

CONSTRUCTION AND TRAFFIC IMPACTS

Construction will take place during nighttime hours. These lane closures will generally take place during off peak hours to minimize traffic congestion and delays for most drivers.

Efforts will be made to limit traffic and noise disruptions, but lane closures, ramp closures and detours will be necessary to accomplish the improvements.

Closures will be announced in advance in the Florida's Turnpike weekly traffic advisory.
