



Spring 2018 Construction Project Update

Sunrise Boulevard and Turnpike Interchange Modification Project

Florida's Turnpike is improving the Turnpike Interchange at Sunrise Boulevard and will be implementing All-Electronic Tolling (AET). Construction began in late 2015 and is anticipated to be completed in late 2019.

Improvements include:

- Constructing a new AET entrance ramp from eastbound Sunrise Boulevard to southbound Turnpike (anticipated completion: late Spring 2018)
- Constructing a new AET exit ramp from northbound Turnpike to eastbound Sunrise Boulevard (anticipated completion: Fall 2018)
- Constructing new single lane tolling sites on the existing northbound exit ramp and southbound entrance ramp, providing more direct access for westbound Sunrise Boulevard
 - ▶ Cash coin toll collection at the existing plaza will be eliminated once these two new electronic tolling sites open (anticipated completion: Summer 2018)
- Replacing and raising the Sunrise Boulevard bridge over the Florida's Turnpike
- Improving pedestrian access and safety by widening the sidewalk, installing a pedestrian cage on the north side of the bridge and striping a designated four-foot bike lane along the north side of Sunrise Boulevard between NW 47 Avenue and NW 56 Avenue.

Please note that this schedule may change due to inclement weather or other unexpected conditions.
