



TURNPIKE WIDENING PROJECT EUREKA DRIVE TO KILLIAN PARKWAY

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

- ◆ Widening Turnpike, including express lanes, from north of Eureka Drive/SW 184th Street to south of Killian Parkway/SW 104th Street
- ◆ Construct sound walls along residential areas adjacent to the Turnpike:
 - ◆ East side: from north of Eureka Drive to south of SW 152nd Street and from north of SW 120th Street to south of Killian Parkway
 - ◆ West side: from north of Eureka Drive to south of SW 168th Street and from north of SW 117th Street to south of Killian Parkway
- ◆ Realignment of Turnpike/SR 874 interchange
- ◆ Consolidation of entrance/exit ramps for SW 120th Street and service plaza ramps will be removed
- ◆ Asphalt milling and resurfacing, bridge widening landscaping, lighting, drainage, traffic signal improvements on local roads and signage improvements.

CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE

Work is anticipated to be completed in spring 2019.

COST AND FUNDING

The project cost is approximately \$145.3 million. This project is funded by toll and concessions revenue, not taxes.



CONSTRUCTION AND TRAFFIC IMPACTS

Construction will take place during both daytime and night time hours. Lane closures will generally take place during off peak hours to minimize traffic congestion and delays for most drivers.

Efforts will be made to limit traffic and noise disruptions, but lane closures, ramp closures and detours will be necessary to accomplish the improvements.

Closures will be announced in advance in the Florida's Turnpike weekly traffic advisory.
