## SOUTH FLORIDA AND TREASURE COAST WEEKLY LANE CLOSURES AND WORK ZONE ADVISORY

**FORT LAUDERDALE** — Florida's Turnpike announces updated lane closures and work zones due to construction and maintenance projects in Miami-Dade, Broward, Palm Beach, Martin and St. Lucie counties, **for the week beginning Sunday, Feb. 27, 2011.**

### TURNPIKE SERVICE PLAZA – SNAPPER CREEK (MILEPOST 19)

- Construction is ongoing at the Snapper Creek service plaza fuel station and all services are available.

### TURNPIKE SERVICE PLAZA – POMPANO BEACH (MILEPOST 65)

- There will be no truck, bus or RV parking available at the Pompano Service Plaza until further notice. There are no restaurants available during construction. The fuel station remains open with limited food and beverage selection.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** All 8 of the service plazas on Florida's Turnpike will be rebuilt over the course of the next few years.

## MIAMI-DADE COUNTY

### TURNPIKE ALL-ELECTRONIC OPEN ROAD TOLLING – U.S. 1 TO COUNTY LINE ROAD (MILEPOST 0-47)

- **County Line Road** – Two eastbound lanes will be closed in the vicinity of Florida's Turnpike, from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. Sunday, Feb. 27, through Saturday, March 5. Traffic will be diverted between Miramar Parkway and northbound Florida's Turnpike.

- **Southbound Turnpike connector to Northwest 27th Avenue** – Closed from 11 p.m. Sunday, Feb. 27, through Saturday, March 5.
  - DETOUR: Traffic should exit at Northwest 199th Street (Exit 2X) and go west to Northwest 27th Avenue.
- The southbound Turnpike connector to the southbound Turnpike Extension has been reduced from two lanes to one lane the next several days, and motorists may experience delays during peak travel times.
- **Northbound Turnpike connector (from Golden Glades) to southbound Turnpike Extension (to Homestead) and southbound Northwest 27th Avenue (Exit 4X)** – Closed from 9 p.m. Sunday, Feb. 27, through Saturday, March 5.
  - DETOUR: Traffic should exit at Northwest 199th Street (Exit 2X), go west to Northwest 27th Avenue and enter the southbound Turnpike Extension.
- **Miramar mainline toll plaza (Milepost 47)** – Several toll lanes will be closed from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. Sunday, Feb. 27, through Saturday, March 5.
- **Northwest 27th Avenue** – One lane in either direction will be closed between County Line Road and Miramar Parkway from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. Sunday, Feb. 27, through Saturday, March 5.
- **Northwest 57th Avenue** – One lane in either direction will be closed in the vicinity of Florida's Turnpike, from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. Sunday, Feb. 27, through Saturday, March 5.
- **Okeechobee Road/U.S. 27** – One or two lanes in each direction closed from 9 p.m. Sunday, Feb. 27, through Saturday, March 5.
- **Southbound Turnpike exit to Northwest 106th Street** – Closed from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. Sunday, Feb. 27, through Saturday, March 5.
  - DETOUR: Motorists will be directed to exit at US 27/Okeechobee Road, go east to Northwest 116th Way, and follow the detour signs to Northwest 106th Street.
- **Northbound Turnpike entrance from Northwest 106th Street** – Closed from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. Sunday, Feb. 27, through Saturday, March 5.
  - DETOUR: Motorists should take Northwest 107th Avenue south to Northwest 41st Street and then west to the Turnpike entrance at that interchange.
- One lane in each direction will be closed nightly along various segments of Florida's Turnpike between the Southwest 8th Street interchange and the Miramar mainline toll plaza from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. Sunday, Feb. 27, through Saturday, March 5.
- **Northwest 41st Street** – One lane in either direction will be closed as needed in the vicinity of the Turnpike 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. Sunday, Feb. 27, through Saturday, March 5.
- **Northwest 12th Street** – One lane in either direction will be closed as needed between Northwest 137th and 112th avenues from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. Sunday, Feb. 27, through Saturday, March 5.
- **State Road 836** – One westbound lane, approaching Florida's Turnpike, will be closed from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. Sunday, Feb. 27, through Saturday, March 5.
- **Southbound Turnpike exit to westbound Southwest 8th Street (Exit 25A)** – Closed for toll plaza demolition the entire weekend, from 9 p.m. Friday, March 4, to 6 a.m. Monday, March 7.

- DETOUR: Motorists should exit the Turnpike at Bird Road/Southwest 40th Street, go east to Southwest 117th Avenue and then north to Southwest 8th Street.
- One or two Turnpike lanes in each direction will be closed between the Bird Road and State Road 836 interchanges and between Caribbean Boulevard and Southwest 120th Street from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. Sunday, Feb. 27, through Thursday, March 3. At least one lane in each direction will remain open.
- **Southbound Turnpike exit to Bird Road/Southwest 40th Street** – Closed from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. for two nights, Monday, Feb. 27, and Tuesday, Jan. 28.
  - DETOUR: Motorists should exit at Southwest 8th Street, go east to Southwest 117th Avenue and then south to Southwest 40th Street.
- **Northbound Turnpike exit to Allapattah Road** – Closed from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. Sunday, Feb. 27, and Monday, Feb. 28.
  - DETOUR: Traffic exit at Biscayne Drive/Southwest 288th Street, go east to Southwest 137th Avenue, north to Southwest 248th Street and then east to Allapattah Road.
- **Southbound Turnpike entrance from Campbell Drive/Southwest 312th Street** – Closed from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. Tuesday, March 1, through Thursday, March 3.
  - DETOUR: Traffic will be detoured west to U.S. 1 and then south to Florida’s Turnpike.
- **Northbound Turnpike exit to Campbell Drive/Southwest 312th Street** – Closed from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. for up to three nights beginning Sunday, Feb. 27.
  - DETOUR: Motorists should exit at Biscayne Drive, go east to Southwest 137<sup>th</sup> Avenue and then go south to Campbell Drive.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** Two construction projects are underway to upgrade the Homestead, Bird Road, Okeechobee and Miramar mainline toll plazas and the 33 ramp plazas located between the U.S. 1 and County Line Road interchanges. The upgrades will allow for [all-electronic open road tolling](#) on this segment of the Turnpike **beginning Saturday, February 19**, when cash toll collections will be eliminated at all the toll plazas. Demolition of toll plazas will continue through late 2011. Approximate combined cost: \$57.8 million.

## **BROWARD COUNTY**

### **TURNPIKE WIDENING – PETERS ROAD (north of I-595) TO SUNRISE BOULEVARD (MILEPOST 55 to 58)**

- One lane to two lanes in the northbound direction will be closed periodically on the Turnpike between Peters Road (Milepost 55) and Sunrise Boulevard (Exit 58) from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. Monday, Feb. 28, through Friday, March 4.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** This project is a multi-million dollar construction program to widen Florida’s Turnpike in Broward County; an additional travel lane is being added to both the northbound and southbound directions. There are three active phases in progress between Griffin Road (Exit 53) and Atlantic Boulevard (Exit 66). Approximate projects cost: \$260 million.

## TURNPIKE WIDENING – SUNRISE BOULEVARD TO ATLANTIC BOULEVARD (MILEPOST 58 to 66)

- One to two northbound and one to two southbound lanes will be closed periodically on the Turnpike between Sunrise Boulevard (Exit 58) and Atlantic Boulevard (Exit 66) from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. Monday, February 28, through Friday, March 4.
- Intermittent ramp closures at the Sunrise Boulevard (Exit 58) northbound entrance and northbound exit between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m. Monday, Feb. 28, through Friday, March 4.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** This project is a multi-million dollar construction program to widen Florida's Turnpike in Broward County; currently there is an additional travel lane being added to the northbound direction.

## **PALM BEACH COUNTY**

### TURNPIKE INTERCHANGE RECONFIGURATION – LAKE WORTH ROAD (MILEPOST 93)

- One southbound and northbound lane will be closed periodically on the Turnpike between the Lantana Toll Plaza (MP 88) and north of Lake Worth Road (Exit 93) from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. Monday, February 28, through Friday, March 4.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** This project is an interchange reconfiguration at the Turnpike's Lake Worth Interchange (Exit 93). This will provide separate access for northbound and southbound drivers. This project's approximate project cost is \$17.5 million and is projected to be completed by the end of February 2011.
